Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the briefing schedule in this matter is revised as follows: any response by the Government to Google Inc.’s Motion for Declaratory Judgment of a First Amendment Right to Publish Aggregate Information About FISA Orders must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 20, 2013. If the Government responds, Google Inc., may file a reply brief no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 27, 2013, through the Security and Emergency Planning Staff, U.S. Department of Justice.
