

ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND

The Court has ordered the government to provide certain information by March 27, 2020. See Corrected Opinion and Order at 17-18, Misc. 19-02 (March 5, 2020). On March 25, 2020, the government, through counsel, orally requested a one-week extension of the time to provide such information, in view of modified staffing and telework practices occasioned by the COVID-19 outbreak. Accordingly, the government's time to provide such information is hereby extended until April 3, 2020.
